Prior to Jiahui, Dr KOH Hau-Tek was General Manager, Raffles Medical, China, and managing & expanding healthcare facilities set-up across 6 cities. He has worked previously in major medical groups in Singapore and the Republic of Ireland and has been a practicing physician for 20 years. Dr KOH has sat on and presided over Medical Boards and Clinical Governance committees in private sector healthcare groups, including Parkway Shenton, Mount Elizabeth Hospital and Healthway Medical Group in Singapore. He was actively involved in multiple large-scale projects in both corporate and government arenas, enhancing scope & quality of clinical services while developing new business lines. He was involved operationally in national outbreaks/pandemics, overseeing preparations and implementation of pandemic workflow at the airport and both hospital and ambulatory centers.
